

Last month, Rancho celebrated the groundbreaking of our new *"No Wrong Door" Youth Outpatient Center*. This milestone was made possible with the Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) Behavioral Health Continuum Infrastructure Program (BHCIP) Round 4 investment.

The Youth Outpatient Center will expand access to outpatient behavioral health services for youth and families, including mental health care, substance use disorder treatment, including prevention and early intervention services. The "No Wrong Door" policy ensures treatment access is available at

any point of entry. Sometimes referred to as a *"system of care approach,"* the framework allows us to coordinate services to ensure personalized and efficient outpatient care.

The demand for accessible, youth-centered behavioral health services in Los Angeles County continues to grow. Investing in spaces where young people feel seen, supported, and safe represents Rancho San Antonio's deep and enduring commitment to our youth.

We extend our heartfelt thanks to Hoffman & Associates Building Corporation, Kluger Architects, the City of Los Angeles, BHCIP, DHCS, Congressman Brad Sherman, Councilmember John Lee, and Rancho's Board of Directors, staff, and Advisory Council for their leadership and advocacy in bringing this project to life. We are grateful for the partnership, the shared vision, and the community support.

As the building progresses, we will post updates on our website and social media accounts. We cannot wait to see the positive impact this center will have on families across our city.
