HOW I BECAME INTERESTED IN TRI-FIVES . . . By Dale Kredell

Often times people ask me how I became interested in Tri-Fives. I am sure this occurs because "I look so young" and this is how I reply.

I grew up in Grosse Point, a suburb of Detroit, Michigan. I was the only boy with 3 younger sisters. My mother had 4 kids by the time she was 22. She got divorced before I turned 7. She caught the eye of a man that changed my life "Bill Kredell." He was an old school auto bodyman. This was in the day of lead, rebuilt ¼ panels with no Bondo. He had built a career in Michigan and began restoring wrecked cars in his garage before the days of salvage title. His cars were beautiful. Bel Airs and Nomads were his favorites, but he always liked English Sports cars as well. He ventured off to California working for Kramer Motors and later opened up a shop on Van Nuys Blvd. near Sherman Way with his friend, George Grey, who later became famous as a Hot Rod Painter.

In 1962, he married my mother and we took off for California on Route 66. We arrived after New Year's in 1963. The trip took 3 days in a 1956 Chevy 2 door Station Wagon, towing a 1957 Plymouth Fury. The '56 wagon became my first car when I was 16.

I am sure I learned to appreciate cars and women from my dad. Before I turned 18, I had bought, fixed up and sold 8 cars. Two were 56 Chevys. The second one had a 348 engine with 4:56 Posi rear-end. It was fast as hell for 2 blocks on Van Nuys Blvd. My other cars were a Triumph TR2, Austin Healy Bug Eye, a '59 Corvette, a '63 Falcon Sprint and a '49 Ford Woody and a couple of Falcons.

Everything I owned I worked for. I owned the '59 Vette for 2 weeks. I had purchased it from the car dealer on Van Nuys across the street from McDonalds. It cost me \$1,500.00. I gave the guy \$1,000 and he took a note for the \$500.00. But when I went to get insurance I couldn't afford it as the insurance cost more than the car. I traded it for the 63 Falcon, no problem with insurance. It came stock as a pre-model of the Mustang, it had a 260 engine, dual carbs, Hurst shifter and cut outs. It blew the doors off of GTOs at the time. Unfortunately, it caught on fire in front of Van Nuys Golf Course and burned to the springs. No comprehensive insurance, my girlfriend and I towed it home with a tow rope the next day.

Prior to my graduation, my dad bought me a used '65 Malibu SS, it needed a little body work and repair. I sold the parts off the Falcon and I fixed up the Malibu. I bought a 327 and rebuilt it in my apartment closet as well as other crazy things. I've been doing crazy things like that ever since and it continued to feed my future obsession with classics.

By 22, I got married, moved on to buying houses, having kids, and building a business. Leaving cars behind for a little while, only to come back, with my '78 Porsche SC in '83. I am a kid that

never grew up. '55's have always been my favorite. This one is my second. "I'll probably have to trade up to a '57 when I grow old."




